

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## **School Uniform Policy**

At Rauceby Church of England Primary Academy we are committed to enabling all children to access education successfully. This is an “inclusive” process. We believe that the way that children dress to attend school has a profound effect on their attitude towards themselves and others and all the work that is undertaken. Therefore a well thought out approach to this aspect contributes directly to both the social and learning aspects of our school.

All children will be offered the same opportunities regardless of race, colour, creed or gender. As a school we acknowledge our legal duties under the Equality Act 2010, in respect of safeguarding and in respect of all pupils.

### **School Uniform**

At Rauceby Church of England Primary Academy we have two uniform standards; one for summer and one for winter.

Summer uniform is to be worn from after the Easter break until the summer holidays and then through to the October half term break. Winter uniform is to be worn from after the October half term break through to Easter.

### **Winter Uniform**

Navy skirt or pinafore dress

Grey trousers

Grey socks

Navy tights or knee length socks

Light blue shirt or blouse

School tie will be worn

Navy cardigan or jumper displaying the school badge

Dark coloured outdoor coat with no obvious large logos – a navy blue coat with crest is available

Shoes – black or dark blue, no trainers

Gloves, scarves and hats can be any colour, the brighter the better for the dark winter nights – no large logos.

## Summer Uniform

Blue and white gingham dress

Light blue short-sleeved or long sleeved shirt

School ties may be worn

Grey trousers or grey shorts

Grey socks – white socks if wearing the dress

Shoes – black or dark blue, no trainers

Dark coloured outdoor coat with no obvious large logos – a navy blue coat with crest is available

## Summer hats

Navy Rauceby baseball caps are available from Nationwide School Uniforms

Baseball hats without large logos may be worn to protect from the sun

## Hair and earrings

Hair must be tied back at all times

All hair accessories must be of a dark colour and of a reasonable size

Only stud type earrings should be worn. Earrings will be asked to be removed or covered for PE lessons where there is a risk of injury

Watches can be worn

No other jewellery should be worn for school unless for a specific religious reason

## PE and Games

All children will change for PE and Games. All children should wear clothing suited to physical activity appropriate to their age.

## Indoor PE

Children should wear navy or black shorts, white sports socks and white polo shirt with Rauceby logo.

Children should take part in lessons in bare feet or trainers.

## **Outdoor PE**

Children will wear the same as indoor sports kit if suitable for the weather.

School sweatshirts can be worn for games/PE

Navy or black tracksuit trousers and tops can be worn – with no large logos.

Navy/black sports socks may be worn for outdoor PE.

Suitable footwear depending on the activity.

A small PE bag can be used.

## **Swimming**

Swimming trunks or costume (no bikinis or baggy Bermuda shorts)

Swimming hats must be worn; these can be purchased from the school office.
