## PARENT CONSULTATIONS AND PROGRESS REPORTS

Here at Rauceby, we value the partnership we have with parents/carers and strive to ensure there is an open communication between home and school throughout the year. We are always happy to discuss worries or concerns that may arise, and teachers are contactable through their class email addresses, through the school office or at the school gate. We know that by working together, our children make the best progress!

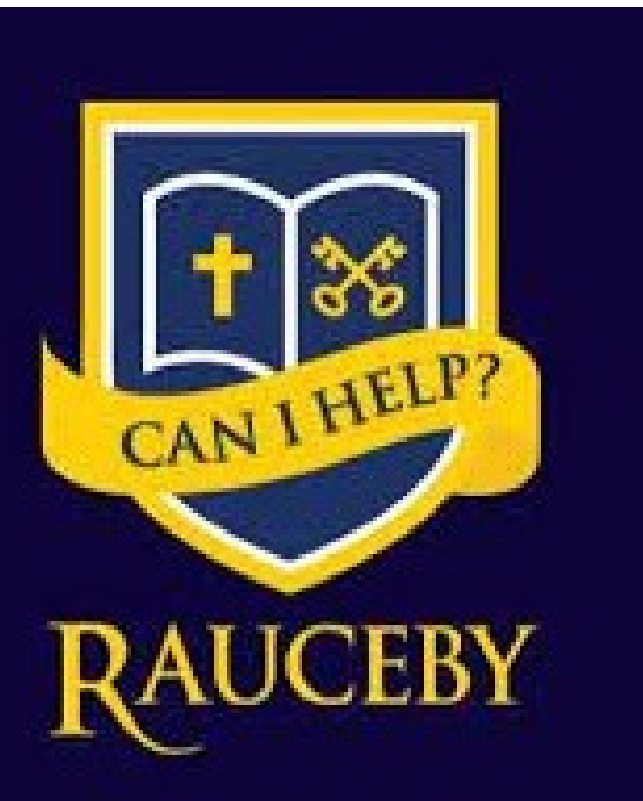
At points throughout the year, we will share with you how your child is progressing academically and personally in school as well as letting you know their current levels of attainment. We do this through Parent Consultations and Progress Reports.

Parent Consultations are scheduled for three times in the year. These are opportunities for you to see your child's work, speak to your child's teacher about how your child is progressing in school, find out what they are enjoying, how they are getting along with others, and discuss any areas that they may find more challenging.

For children in Y1 - Y6, there will be two interim progress reports sent to you during the year and these will inform you of your child's current academic attainment in English and maths. The report will also let you know how your child is progressing from their last assessment and from their starting points in either YR (Y1 and Y2) or from Y2 (Y3 - Y6). Your child will also be given some targets to work towards in these subject areas.

At the end of the academic year, you will receive a more detailed report which will outline your child's end of year attainment in English, maths and science and their progress and effort in other curriculum subjects. For EYFS, the end of year report will focus on how well your child is meeting the Early Learning Goals. If your child is in Y1, you will also receive their results for the phonics test and, if they are in Y2 and Y6, you will receive their results from the Standardised Assessment Tests.

If your child has a special need, there will be further opportunities for you to meet with our SENDCO, Mrs Ashford to discuss your child's individual Rauceby Education Plan.

## TERM TWO

Interim reports for Y1 - Y6 will tell you how well your child is achieving and progressing in the core subjects

## TERM THREE

## TERM FIVE

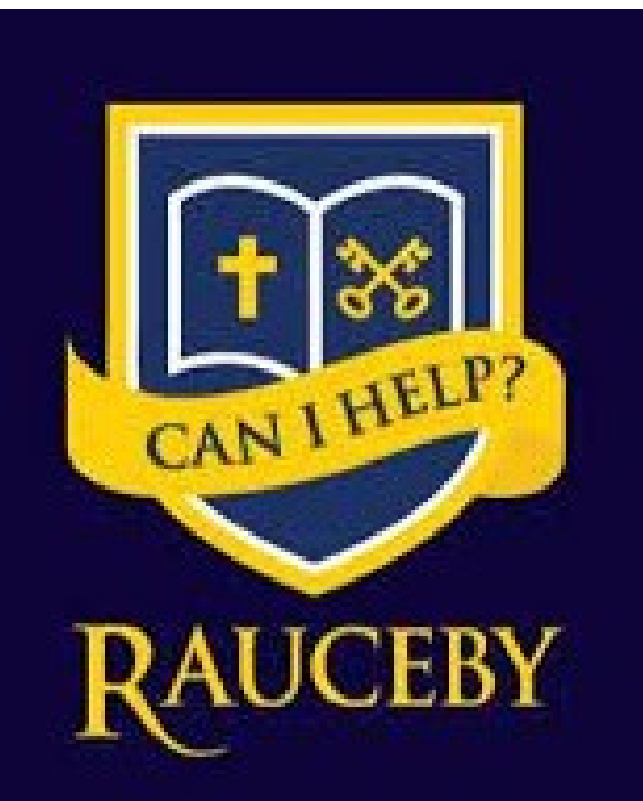
Parent Consultation: an opportunity to share your child's learning and discuss how your child is progressing.
